



ASSEMBLY OF DELEGATES COMMITTEE HIGHLIGHTS

The following brief summary is being provided to you with what our Committees, Councils and Task Forces will be discussing during their meetings on Thursday through Saturday November 11-13, 2010 to help you decide what meetings you would like to attend based on your specific interests.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING TASK FORCE

The Affordable Housing Task Force will discuss the status of several pieces of affordable housing legislation as well as emerging issues. Further, the Task Force will deliberate over federal legislative priorities for 2011.

ASSOCIATION EXECUTIVES COUNCIL

The AEC will announce the officers elected to serve for 2011. The Council will also review its successes over the past year and discuss future opportunities as they relate to affiliate priorities.

BUDGET AND FINANCE

The Committee will be reviewing the September 2010 financial statements. The committee will also discuss the 2011 budgets for NAA and the NAA Education Institute to be presented to the NAA Board of Directors and Assembly of Delegates.

COMMUNICATIONS ADVISORY BOARD

NAA staff will update the CAB on the continuing progress of the NAA Community Site, which launched in November. CAB will also discuss NAA's efforts on the AptLY Spoken blog and brainstorm for story sources and authors to meet the needs of the 2011 Editorial Calendar.

2011 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

The 2011 Conference Committee will discuss and review its plan of work, registration goals and objectives for the 2011 NAA Education Conference & Exposition. The Committee will accomplish this by breaking into subcommittees and then discussing with the group as a whole their action plans.

GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE

The Governance Committee will review the following challenges of scheduling 17 committees at our 3 National Meetings. Not enough time for the meeting; Meetings overlap; No one should serve on more than 2 committees. No Committee reports at AOD unless there are "action items"; Drop AOD meeting at Education Conference due to intense schedule; Continue to have a Board Meeting. What are the Core Committees; Too Many Vacant spots at the Table (Many committee members are not showing up to the meeting or if at the National meeting, don't attend the committee meeting); Bottom Line – Need longer hours for meeting with fewer committees.

INDEPENDENT RENTAL OWNERS COMMITTEE

The Independent Rental Owner Committee (IROC) will highlight its successes this year, which includes: an IRO forum and networking event at the NAA Education Conference, a conference call discussing industry best practices and marketing strategies in support of enhancing affiliates growth with IROC and ROC related programs. The IROC will also discuss ideas for a final conference call in December that will be open to all IRO members.
