Safety Guidelines When Hosting a Maintenance Mania Event

Hosting large events has been drastically affected by COVID-19 and has required a major adjustment on the part of associations and venues. In order to host a successful Maintenance Mania® event, here are a few safety tips to consider to make your event fun and safe. Please note, while the following measures will help in minimizing risk, we recommend additional safety precautions be implemented based on state/local regulations.



Wear a face covering.



Practice social distancing.



Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

- Masks should be used as a method to suppress transmission. Masks are most essential in times when physical distancing is difficult (e.g., when moving within a crowd or audience).
- As an added safety precaution, competitors should practice social distancing and stand six-feet away from each other when competing. We also recommend not engaging in any physical interactions, including high-fives and chest bumps. It is also recommended that affiliates use physical guides, such as tape markings on floors or signs on walls, directing attendees to remain at least 6 feet apart from each other.
- Your local HD Supply support team will provide disinfecting products to clean all materials once they arrive on site. Additionally, they will clean all materials at the conclusion of your event. Affiliates will be responsible for providing any additional PPE items for their competitors (masks, hand sanitizer, additional disinfecting products). Because the games are considered high-touch surfaces, it is highly recommended that each game be properly sanitized after each competitor's turn.
